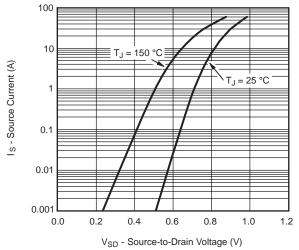

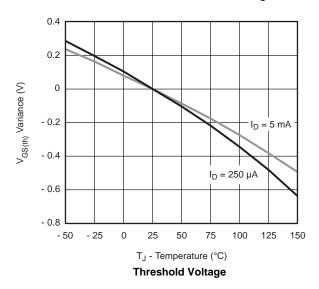


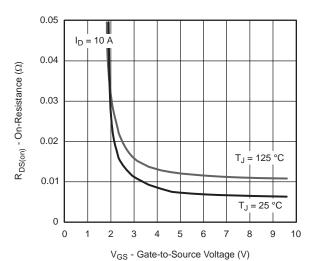


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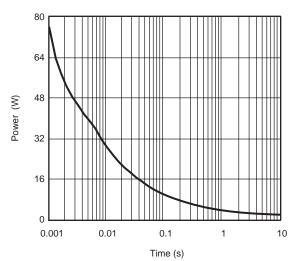


#### Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage

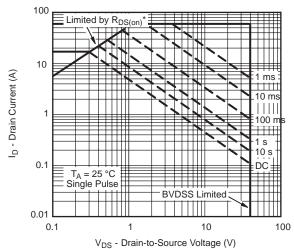




On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage



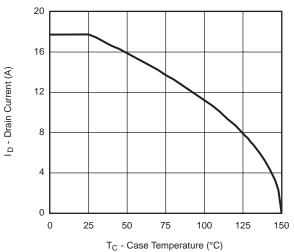
Single Pulse Power, Junction-to-Ambient

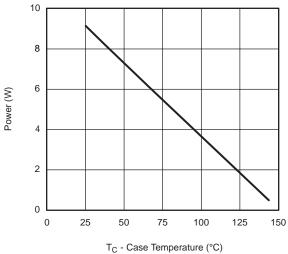
Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient

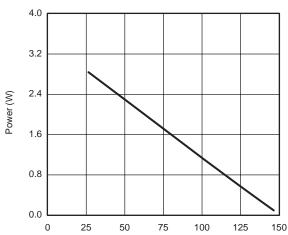

Power, Junction-to-Ambient



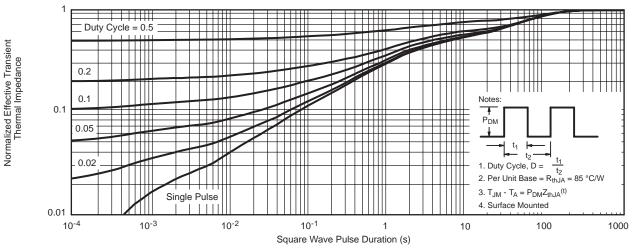
T<sub>A</sub> - Ambient Temperature (°C)

Power Derating, Junction-to-Foot

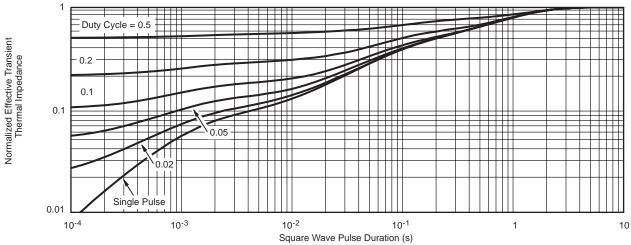
