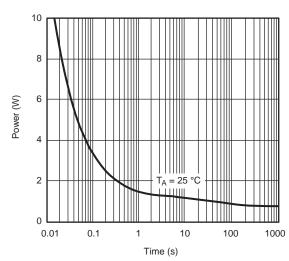


Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage

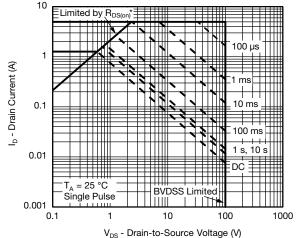




On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage



Single Pulse Power

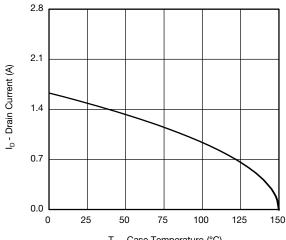

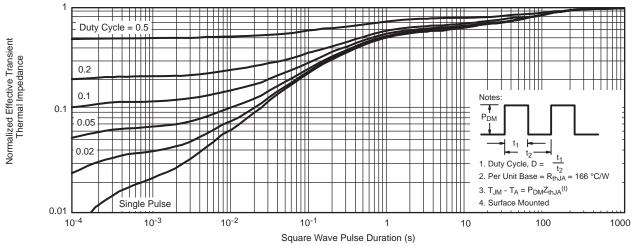




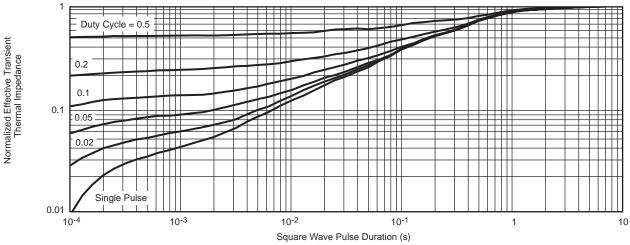
 $^{^*}$ The power dissipation P_D is based on $T_{J(max)} = 150$ °C, using junction-to-case thermal resistance, and is more useful in settling the upper dissipation limit for cases where additional heatsinking is used. It is used to determine the current rating, when this rating falls below the package limit.

Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Foot

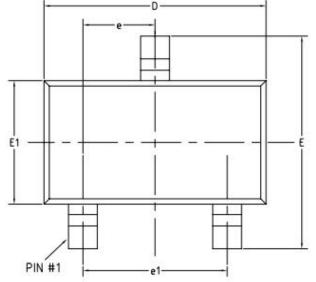

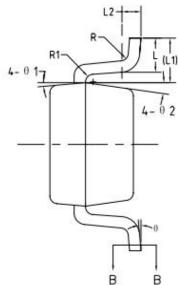

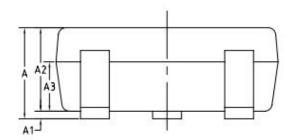
- Normalized Transient Thermal Impedance Junction-to-Foot (25 °C) are given for general guidelines only to enable the user to get a "ball park" indication of part capabilities. The data are extracted from single pulse transient thermal impedance characteristics which are developed from empirical measurements. The latter is valid for the part mounted on printed circuit board - FR4, size 1" x 1" x 0.062", double sided with 2 oz. copper, 100 % on both sides. The part capabilities can widely vary depending on actual application parameters and operating conditions.

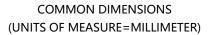


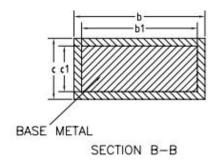
